It borders the N postcode area to the west, both north of the tidal Thames. Sinc e closure of the East London mail centre, its mail is sorted at Romford Mail Cen tre together with IG and RM postcode areas.</p> <p>Postal administration [edit]</p> <p>The current E postcode area was originally formed in 1866 as a merger o f the E and NE areas, which had been created in 1858. In 1917, the postal distri cts were numbered alphabetically by their most important parish, chapelry, topog raphical or built environment feature.[3] As of 2004, the district names do not form part of the postal address.[2] High demand caused sector 9 of the E1 postco de district to be split and recoded in 1999 to create an E1W postcode district a round Wapping,[4] but the rest of the district did not gain an additional charac ter.
